Meals are served buffet style in a central dining room for conference participants.

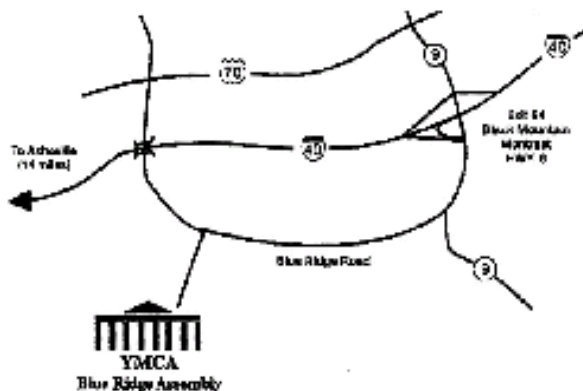
LOCATION

Blue Ridge Assembly is located 17 miles east of Asheville via I-40 and two miles off the Interstate. Traveling on I-40 take exit 64, "Black Mountain/Montreat" and turn south on Highway 9. Proceed less than one-half mile and go straight on Blue Ridge Road. Travel 0.9 mile and turn left at small Blue Ridge Assembly sign, then proceed to our entrance.

Asheville airport is a short 35 minute drive from the Assembly, offering shuttle service for a fee.

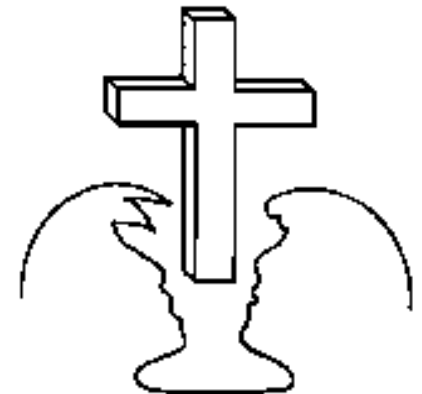
